Dear Northlake Members and Friends,

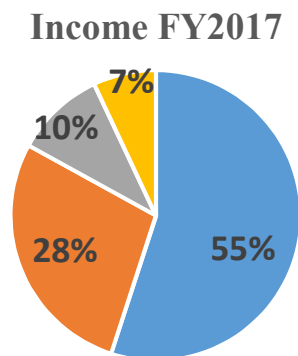

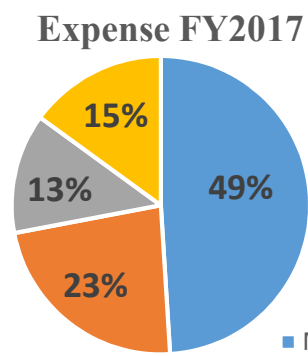


Every spring Northlake develops its budget for the upcoming year. An important item in the budget is the pledged contributions. Certain trends, such as increased costs for health insurance and child care, generate a consequent need for everyone, you and me, to increase our pledges. Your generosity in the past has markedly contributed to positive growth with everything in place for this trend to continue. We just need for you to provide the support. **Please give generously.**

Our projected pledge goal is 15% larger than last year.



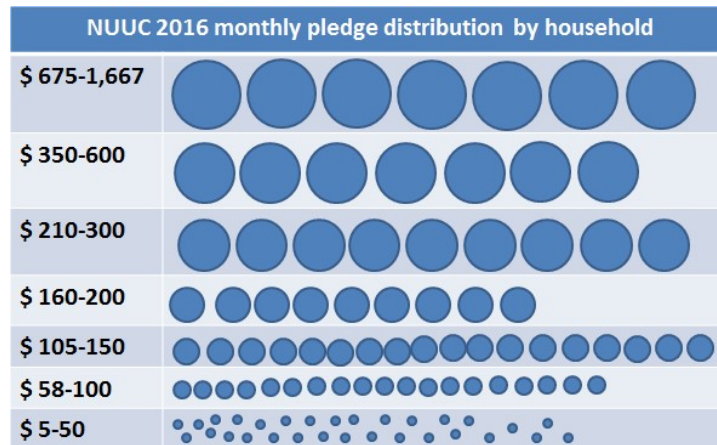

Each year our expenses tend to increase, and FY2018 is expected to be no different. Staff costs, bookkeeping, childcare and health care costs are increasing along with Building and Grounds projects supporting our Green Sanctuary initiative. Rental income is expected to decrease, aligning with our long-range plans to increase the availability of our space for our own programs.

As you decide on the amount you will be pledging for FY2018, please review the chart below. Based on the Unitarian Universalist Association (UUA) guidelines for a financially healthy congregation, we depend too much on a few large contributors. It would be better for our overall financial health if those in the bottom two-thirds could increase their pledges. If you raise your pledge by 20% or more, we will publicly recognize you by name, or anonymously if you prefer. If this is your first time pledging, we will also recognize you by name unless you prefer to remain anonymous.



Your pledge packet includes a pledge form and a copy of the Suggested Fair Share Monthly Contribution Guide adapted from the UUA. We hope you find the guide and discussion at a cottage dinner useful as you decide the amount of your pledge. Please fill out the pledge form and mail it to the church or place it in the basket at Sunday service by May 7. If you opted for electronic communications, you will receive an email with instructions and a link where you may complete your pledge form online.

In May, the Finance Committee and Board of Trustees will work together to finalize the FY2018 operating budget. At the Congregational Meeting on June 11, members will vote to approve the final budget.
